


The Gustavus Alumni Mentoring Program was founded in 2010 with the goal of connecting Economics and Management majors with successful Gustavus alumni who could help them gain relevant business experience.



The program, which began as a class research project, offers substantial benefits to both students and alumni. Students learn real-world business practices, build their resumes, and begin establishing their professional network, while alumni have a chance to share their knowledge, meet tomorrow's job seekers, and reconnect with their alma mater.

The yearlong mentoring program is currently open only to Economics and Management majors and includes an opening banquet, monthly communications between students and mentors, a potential job shadow opportunity, and a closing banquet. A January IEX internship is also encouraged.
