the Warren & Donna Beck Academic Hall contributes to excellence in the teaching and learning experience, provides an attractive and beneficial asset to the campus, and promotes environmental stewardship.



The building houses five academic departments: Communication Studies, Economics and Management, History, Psychology, and Sociology and Anthropology. Notable features include state-of-the-art classroom tools and technologies, psychology labs to help foster student-faculty collaboration and interdisciplinary research, digital arts lab, studio space for GAC-TV and KGSM radio, large forensics team room, and dedicated space for the neuroscience program.

Aside from being a space for engaged learning, it is also environmentally friendly. It exceeds the State of Minnesota Sustainable Building 2030 targets, saves 44 percent more energy and 30 percent more water than current code requirements. The main highlight of the LEED-certified (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) building comes from its solar panels, which provide both electricity and hot water. Visitors to the building can see its real-time energy consumption via a monitor “dashboard” located in the lobby.

As it is the first academic building added to campus in more than 20 years, this is the perfect opportunity to show your support for Gustavus students, faculty, and the future of education by naming an area of the building. Many opportunities are still available, including faculty offices, classrooms, labs, studios, learning suites, and work rooms.
