Starting with a plaza and amphitheater surrounded by prairie vegetation, the elliptical mall flows toward Campus Drive echoing the plantings of the arboretum and Minnesota landscape through an oak savannah, deciduous trees, and finally a boreal forest. Its paths will consist of crushed limestone. Green open areas will provide plenty of space for activities and inspire professors to move classes outside.

The versatile amphitheater will celebrate the arts, with theatrical and musical

performances taking center stage. It's a perfect space for making memories and strengthening ties to the greater Gustavus community.
