This option is geared toward the Gustavus student who spends many weekends away from campus, has a lighter appetite, usually eats 10-13 meals per week on campus, and purchases few convenience food items in the Market Place's Grab-n-Go area. Student meal accounts will be credited monthly allocations in September, October, November, March, April, and May with the amount determined by the number of service days in the month. December, January, and February will be allocated together due to limited number of service days in this portion of the academic calendar. Up to \$20.00 may be carried forward from month to month and students who go over the monthly allocation will automatically move into the next months balance. | | |
| Option 2 - \$3300.00 per year to be billed in two installments along with Fall and Spring semester tuition. This option is geared toward the student who spends greater than half of the weekends on campus, usually eats 13-17 meals per week on campus, and purchases some convenience/grocery items in the Market Place's Grab-n-Go area. Student meal accounts will be credited monthly allocations in September, October, November, March, April, and May with the amount determined by the number of service days in the month. December, January, and February will be allocated together due to limited number of service days in this portion of the academic calendar. Up to \$20.00 may be carried forward from month to month and students who go over the monthly allocation will automatically move into the next months balance. | | |
